REQUEST AN APPLICATION:

- Email TeenAmbassadors@homeschoolidaho.org to request an application. You will be contacted by the Teen Ambassador Coordinator.
- Application period: October 9, 2019 – January 9, 2020
- Please be sure to return your completed application postmarked no later than January 9, 2020.
- Consent form required with application.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY:

- Teen Ambassador positions are open to privately home educated students ages 14-18.
- Student must be privately home educated during the current school year.

DUTIES:

- Help with set-up starting at approximately 8:00 a.m.
- Accept pies as they are delivered to the front of the Statehouse.
- Greet and escort legislators around the displays.
- Deliver whole pies to various legislators' and other officials' offices around the Capitol complex.
- Assist with clean-up after 2:00 p.m.

DRESS GUIDELINES:

- Please wear business attire to honor the professional atmosphere of the Idaho Statehouse.
- Young Ladies: Modest dress/skirt & blouse with sleeves, and hemline at or below the knees, hosiery (no leggings) and comfortable dress shoes; light colored nail polish; simple jewelry; clean well-groomed hair; no hats.
- Young Men: Dark dress slacks, collared pressed dress shirt, tie, and comfortable dress shoes. Sport coat or suit if possible; clean, trimmed, and well-groomed head and facial hair. No tennis shoes, jeans, or hats.

ORIENTATION:

- **A required training/orientation will be held** prior to the event. This is a fun time to get to know your fellow ambassadors, as well as acquaint you with your duties and Capitol protocols. An additional briefing will be held on Legislative Day. Please wear your selected attire to the orientation as well as to Legislative Day.
